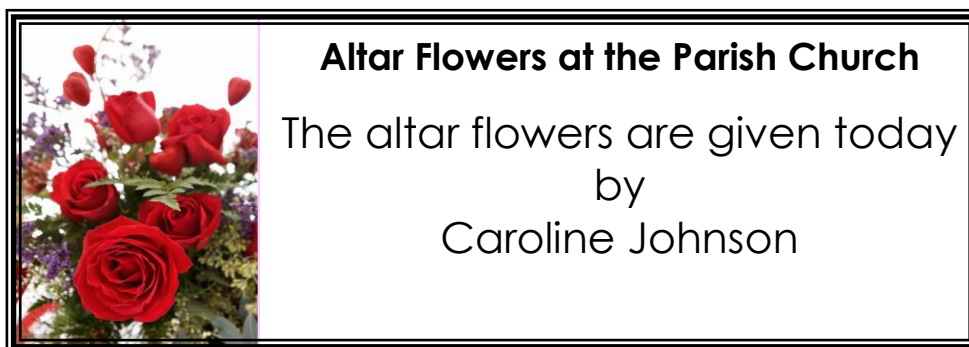
### Thank You
